Dear Parent/ Carer,

We would like to re-introduce ourselves as your School Health and Wellbeing team. We are here to support all children and young people around healthy lifestyle, immunisation, emotional health and wellbeing, as well as additional support for children with long-term health conditions.

This year your child will take part in the **National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP)** which is when children in England in *Reception* and *Year 6* are weighed and measured each year at school. These measurements are taken to provide information about children's growth and development.
