COEL challenge



This challenge is all about children exploring everyday objects in their homes using a feely bag. It's a multi-sensory game which is perfect for the development of oral language skills and vocabulary. It keeps children engaged and helps to develop their turn taking and sharing skills. Have fun playing this game with your child.

First

Find a bag or a box to put your objects in. Look around your house and collect toys and everyday objects. Make sure your objects have different textures, different sizes, colours, different functions. For example, you can put in your box/bag rubber gloves, toothbrush, furry teddy, a sponge, a stone, a squeezy ball, toys that have wheels woolly hat, tomato, pasta.



Next

Show your family what you have collected. Describe each object using lots of descriptive words. Is your object smooth, rough, soft, bumps, prickly, squishy? What can you do with your objects? Does it have wheels? Do you need to wind it to move? What size is it? What colour is it?

Then

Put all your objects in the bag/box. Without looking put your hand in the bag/box and feel the object. Then describe it to your family without showing them. Your family has to guess what object you are describing. Take turn feeling the objects and guessing with your family. Remember to send us photos of your objects.
