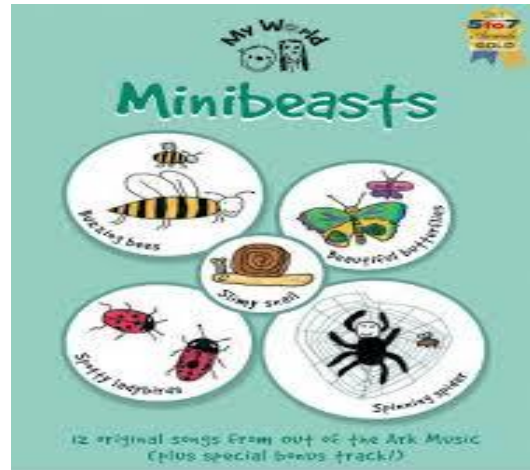


COEL challenge



This week's challenge is around the theme of minibeasts! It's that time of the year where we can find lots of minibeasts in our homes, gardens and local parks.

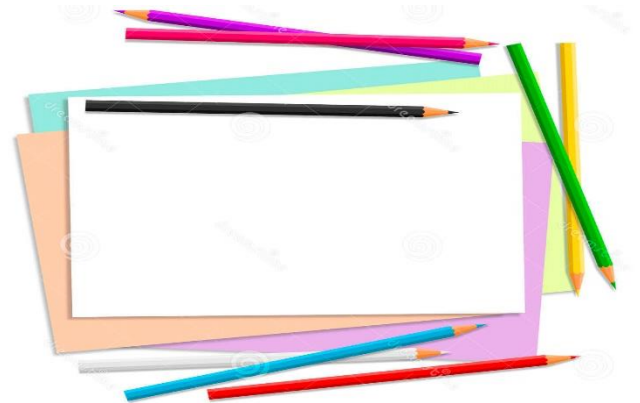
I hope you enjoy it.

First

Collect some paper, colouring pencils (a camera too if you have one) and take them with you when you go outside into your garden or for a walk in the park/outside area.

What minibeasts can you find? Try looking under plant pots or stones, look under and on leaves, bushes and around plants/flowers.

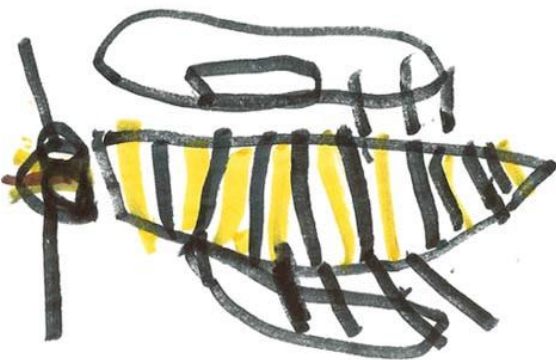


Next

Take a photo of what minibeasts you have found and draw a picture of them.

How many legs do they have? What shape is their body? Can you see any patterns on the minibeast? Do they have wings?

Add detail to your drawing and write the name of the minibeast under your picture.



Then

Try making a model minibeast!

You could use playdough or empty cardboard boxes and tubes.

Empty yoghurt pots or plastic bottles, lids and foil are great to use to create your minibeast. You can use paper to colour in different insect patterns to stick to your model.
