

EYFS Weekly Challenge



Hello everyone, hope you are all well and safe.

This week I would like you to have a go at making a shaker with me. You can use your musical instrument to explore sound. It's also a great way to explore movement, by matching movement to music and singing simple songs from memory. I would love to sing 'twinkle twinkle little star' when I finish making my musical instrument.



First

Have a look around in your home and collect 2 containers of same size. You can use containers like yoghurt pots or paper cups. I am using paper cups for my shaker.

Fill in one of the pot/cup half way full with objects like buttons, rice, pasta or beans.



Next

Glue the two pots/cups together or wrap tape around the rim/lip of both containers.

Make sure to use enough tape to secure them tightly together.

Then

Decorate your shaker by painting it or by covering it with different media or materials like fabric, coloured paper, glitter, sequences etc.

Once your shaker is dry, have lots of fun by making music with it!

What else would you like to make next? Ask a member of you family to help you to search for it on the computer.
