

 - Expressive arts and design





Frequently Asked Questions

- When will my child start school?
- Usually we have a staggered intake in September. Small groups of 5/6 children start each day over a one two-week period. Given that schools reopen in September, you will be notified of your child's start date by July 2022. If not, we will keep you informed.
- Is my child full time straight away?

The first day of your child will come in for half day from 9.00am- 12.00pm they will have lunch then leave at 12.00pm. From the second day they will be in school full time from 8.55am – 3.30pm.

- Can I come in to settle my child in school during the settling in period?

 Yes. Parents are welcome to settle their children. Children usually come from nurseries and are confident young learners and do not need a long time to settle in with their parents.
- Are there clubs/ breakfast clubs before and after school for Reception students? What clubs are there for children with working parents? Yes, there are. We have a breakfast club that is available every morning from 8.00am. After-school clubs with limited numbers are available usually until 5.00pm. These clubs are chargeable. For more information please check the website and to sign up please speak to a member of the office.
- What are the arrangements for lunch/ healthy schools' guidance?

We follow the Tower Hamlets Healthy School Initiative. Students are provided with a nutritious and healthy meal. The menu can be viewed in this pack and on our website. The meals are free to all students as part of the government funding for students in Reception to Year 2.

Do I need to fill in a form for Free School Meals/ Pupil Premium?

Yes. This form will be a part of your Admissions Forms. This is very important to gather information on who is truly eligible for Free School Meals. Those eligible means that those students are Pupil Premium. Registering for free meals could also raise an extra £1,320 for your child's primary school.

Frequently Asked Questions Continued...

What if my child has a food allergy?

Please fill out the medical section as part of the admissions forms to let us know of your child's allergies. If you have not filled out the medical form please speak to the school office. Your child will have an allergy badge created before they start school clearly stating their food allergies. They will have to wear the badge every time they go for a school lunch.

Do I need to bring in extra clothing?

Yes. We highly recommended bringing in extra clothing in a bag. This is in case your child has an accident; they have a second set of clothes to change into. Please label **all** clothing and the bag clearly.

How are visits to the toilets managed?

Within Reception we promote independence in toileting as part of the student learning. However, we understand that children may need support to become familiar with the toilets.

During the first two weeks we support children by prompting them to go to the toilet and regularly take children to the toilet. After the settling in period the children will be prompted to go to the toilet by themselves and staff are on hand to support children when necessary with their individual needs.

• Will my child receive a home visit

Families that are new to Ben Jonson coming in from nurseries other than Ben Jonson Nursery will receive a home visit. The home visits will take place in July 2022. We will write to you in plenty of time to arrange this with you. This is subject to government guidelines on social distancing and making sure staff and families are safe.

We are happy to be receiving a high number of students whose families are familiar with the school. This means that they would not need a home visit. Although you will not receive a home visit a member of the Reception team will telephone you around the end of June/beginning of July to find out about your child and give you a chance to tell us if there is anything special we need to know before s/he starts school. We will keep in contact with all families about the enrollment process via email.

Before September ...

When you child starts Reception there are a number of skills that they should ideally have mastered:

Self-care:

- Go to the toilet by self
- Be able to wash own hands
- Dress and undress by self
- Button and unbutton clothes
- Put on own shoes and socks
- Put on coat and do zip
- Eat using knife and fork

Speaking & Literacy:

- Show an interest in books
- Recognise and write own name
- Talk about myself, needs & feelings
- Ask and answer simple questions

Numeracy:

- Count to 5 and beyond
- Recognise numbers to 5 and beyond
- Using positional language
- •Name 2D and 3D shapes

Listening and understanding:

- Be able to tidy up
- Follow instructions
- Share and take turns
- Talk to other children

Parent Pay

Here at Ben Jonson we use an online payment system – ParentPay - to make it easier for you to pay our school for trips, clubs and all other contributions that you make to the school. This will also allow us to offer you full receipts and records of all payments you have made and help the school save money as we are a completely cashless school.

You have a secure online account, activated using a unique activation username and password; you will be prompted to change these and to keep them safe and secure as your Username and Password for future logins. These will be given to you after your child starts school from September 2022 and signing up is mandatory.

If you already have a ParentPay account, either with our school or another ParentPay school, you can simply login to that account and add your other child/children via the Add a child tab on your home page. You will need your activation username and password to do this.
